Submerged Objects at Lake Awoonga Recreational Users Urged to Take Care

The Gladstone Area Water Board (GAWB) would like to remind fishing and recreational users to take extra care when operating watercraft or swimming at Lake Awoonga.

With dam capacity now below 80% the water level is approximately 3 metres lower than when full (100%). As water levels fall due to lack of rain, old trees and other objects are now just below the water line.

GAWB will continue to monitor this issue and signage has also been installed at the lake to notify users of the potential hazards.
