Gladstone Area Water Board kicks off Calliope River Anabranche Bridge Pipeline Renewal Project

Intermittent road closures expected

The Gladstone Area Water Board (GAWB) will commence work on the Calliope River Anabranche Bridge Pipeline Renewal Project on Monday 4 November.

Located on the northern side of the Calliope River Anabranche Bridge on Gladstone Road, the project will aim to restore sections of the old pipeline between the Curtis Island Pump Station and Wiggins Island Coal Export Terminal (WICET) off take.

This work is critical to maintaining sustainable connections between GAWB's water treatment plants and delivery network.

Construction will be completed by mid-December with intermittent road closures expected in both directions for approximately six weeks. GAWB is working with its stakeholders to limit traffic disruptions as much as possible.

To ensure the project is safely delivered, drivers are encouraged to be patient and obey all traffic management instructions during this time.
